

Clothing Project Information

When selecting projects, members must meet age and other requirements as listed in the current Family Guide. Members may deviate from project guidelines if they wish, but that may exclude them from county winner.

Judging: Clothing project members are required to bring to judging a completed project book, the pattern used in the project (purchased or your own design) and your outfit with appropriate accessories and undergarments. Some projects require a written report. Clothing evaluations will be a 2-part procedure. Members will first carry their finished project into the judge for the interview. After the interview, the member will return for the second step wearing the completed project.

Multiple Projects: 4-H's who take more than one clothing project must complete separate learning experiences related to each, including creating a separate complete outfit FOR EACH PROJECT. Using items from two or more projects to form one outfit will not be considered as a "completion" of either project.

Note: Advanced projects- all obviously hand constructed items in the project must be made by the member. Blouses or tops may be purchased to coordinate with project.
