2024 Coshocton / Tuscarawas Lamb & Wool Queen Application Guidelines

The duties of the queen are to promote the lamb and wool industries at fairs and festivals and special events. Specific requirements include:

- ➤ Each contestant must return completed application by the October 18, 2023 deadline.
- > Contestants must be at least 14 years old as January 1, 2023.
- Contestant must be a resident of Coshocton or Tuscarawas County.
- Contestants must have an interest in the sheep industry. This could include living or working on a sheep farm, exhibit sheep in 4-H or FFA, or have a specific interest in the lamb and wool industry.
- Contestant must be available for a variety of appearances/events throughout the year with the primary focus of promotion of eating lamb and wearing wool.
 - High priorty events include
 - Working in the lamb promotion food stand at the Ohio State Fair in July/August
 - Handing out ribbons and awards for the Coshocton & Tuscarawas
 County Fair Jr. Sheep shows in September and October
 - Promoting lamb and wool during the Fall Foliage and Farm Tour in Coshocton County (mid to late October)
 - Other possible events include community agriculture focused events (such as First Farm Friday in August in Coshocton County or similar events in Tuscarawas County)
 - Participation in parades is encouraged but is not a requirement
