4-H clubs are to be hosts and hostesses in the Youth Building. You need to circulate through the building, greeting visitors and answering questions concerning clubs, projects, and activities. Pick up name tags at the office in the Youth Building to wear so visitors can identify you. Initial above showing that your club worked its shift. Do not leave the building until the next shift arrives. If the shift does not show up, contact Jenny Strickler or Pat Snyder through the Youth Building Office, Jr. Fair Office in Jr. Fair Sheep Barn, or Sr. Fair Board Office. Jenny may also be reached at the Extension Office at 622-2265.

**\*Opening Building** - Clubs responsible for opening the building obtain the key from the Sr. Fair Board Office and return it there. Please see that the floor is swept in the stage section of the building. Brooms are kept in the broom closet next to Baby Care Area. Pick up any trash in the two 4-H sections.

**\*\*Sweeping Center Section** - Clubs on second shift need to sweep the aisles of the center section (4-H) of the building.

**\*\*\*Closing Building** - Clubs responsible for closing the building need to close ALL doors and check that they are secure, make sure any trash inside, including that from the Baby Care Area, is put outside the building at the main door, and turn out lights. Walk around the outside of the building and check all doors to see that they are locked. Get the key from Sr. Fair Board Office at 9:00 PM for locking up and return key to the Sr. Fair Board Office. If you have a conflict please arrange to exchange duty time with another club.

Projects are released at 8:00 AM Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup>. When tearing down booths, please put all trash in stage area of building - do not leave in booth space.

It is very important that all clubs have a representative show up for their assigned duty time. These are valuable projects and we all need to do our part to guard them and tell the public about 4-H.
