4. Third-time participants recite the Head and Heart portions of the 4-H Creed.
5. Fourth-time participants recite the Hands and Health portions of the 4-H Creed.
6. Fifth-time participants who recite the entire 4-H Creed will receive a certificate.
7. Recitals are not judged nor placed competitively. No credit towards incentive awards.
8. Cloverbud participants receive a participation award each time they speak.
