

2019 Final Jr. Fair Changes

All Livestock

1. No sides on tents located in any livestock areas

Goat

Rule Changes

1. Add “pronged collar” as acceptable collar to show in.
2. Add to rule 19: “Tattoos must be visible and match paperwork”
3. Change goat weigh in time to 5:30-7pm
4. Add barn meeting for all sheep and goat exhibitors starting at 5pm prior to weigh in.

Dairy

Rule Changes

1. Add statement for fitting classes “All classes will be entering the ring at the same time but judged separately”

Sheep

Rule Changes

1. Add barn meeting for all sheep and goat exhibitors starting at 5pm prior to weigh in.

Swine

Rule Changes

1. Correct weigh in times to 5-9pm instead of 5-10pm.

Poultry

Rule Changes

1. Remove E – duplicate statement
2. Change H for broilers: weight between 6-8 pounds
3. Broiler hatch start July 31st
4. Duck hatch start July 24th
5. Turkey hatch May 29th-June 21st
6. Blood testing change from 9am-Noon to 9-10am on the 1st Saturday of September

Class Changes

1. Split class 2 showmanship into 15 & 16 year olds and 13 & 14 year olds
2. Add duck pair class – bantam and fancy (the birds shown in this class cannot be shown in any other class except showmanship)
3. Class #19 and #20 add “chicken”
4. Add peewee showmanship

Rabbits

Rule Changes

1. Show starts at 11:00am
2. Rule 2-C: Rabbits should be under 90 days of age (previously 80)
3. Market Rabbit Tattoo date will be September 7th, 10am-Noon
4. Rabbit weigh in will be Thursday night 7-8pm

1. Add lionhead as a breed class, remove satin breed class

1. Combine Male and Female cat classes into one
2. Combine sow and boar guinea pig classes into one
3. Add first year showmanship
4. Change showmanship order to: senior, junior, first year, supreme

Rule Changes

1. Lease paperwork due to OSU Extension Office by June 1st.
2. Show starts at 8am

Special Interest

1. Change Tasting Smorgasbord to a 12:30pm start time.
2. Public Speaking will be 9/28 7pm, and 10/1 10am

Class Changes

1. Add supreme showmanship class

More changes may follow pending the state dog class revisions

Horse

June 1st is mandatory horse check in. Check in is 4:30-5:30pm (mandatory), safety and ethics from 5:30-6:30pm (mandatory), 6:30-7pm dinner, and clinic starting at 7pm.

Horseless horse project will switch to be under special interest (and be evaluated as such), rather than as a horse project.

Rule Changes

1. Follow state fair rules for production – meaning youth may only take a production animal once they have passed their 13th birthday (previously no age requirement)

Class Changes

1. Remove: Hunter Hack, Walk Only Barrels, 2 walk/trot classes
2. Add: Beginner walk/trot, beginner pleasure (English/western), intermediate pleasure (English/western), advanced pleasure western, advanced pleasure english, beginner trail, intermediate trail, advanced trail, beginner equitation/horsemanship, intermediate equitation/horsemanship, advanced equitation, advanced horsemanship.
