

2024 Final Jr. Fair Changes

All Livestock

Rule Changes

1. Add Rule #54 “There is to be no personal video surveillance equipment inside the buildings outside of fair board approved equipment.”
2. Remove #24 in general rules “In the Supreme Showmanship Classes, half of all participants will be placed, up to a maximum of 10 placings”
3. Modify rule #33 from general rules “Grooming of all Jr. Fair animals is limited to the member, any junior fair exhibitors, parents/guardians, siblings, and grandparents of the exhibitor, and advisors in Coshocton County. Rule applies to all junior fair animals during the entire week of the fair.”

Goat

Class Changes

1. For Dam and daughter classes – change daughter “must be less than one year of age by show day”

Poultry

Rule Changes

1. Turkey hatch on or after June 3
2. Duck hatch on or after July 29
3. Broiler hatch on or after August 5
4. Remove #5 “Market chickens must weigh between six and eight pounds. Market chickens not weighing six to eight pounds will show in a separate class” – rule is a duplicate
5. Show time starts at 8am and will be in junior fair arena

Sheep

Rule Changes

1. Remove option to allow them to pull the second sheep from the carcass show final drive, #11 and #40 in general rules.

Other

1. Move sheep show back to the junior fair arena.

Horse

Class Changes

1. Combine walk/trot classes 1 and 2, and classes 5 and 6.
2. Combine contest showmanship 1 and 2
3. Separate English classes from 3, 4, 7, and 8. Combine all the ages so 2 classes for each total

Rule Changes

1. Show start time 9am, order: Showmanship, performance, contest

Beef

Class Changes

1. Add dairy steer class as class 3 under market beef show, add classes (steers, feeders).

Rule Changes

1. Remove “All animals must weigh a minimum of 900 pounds at time of fair” from rate of gain area.
