Thursday, April 7 - Throwback Thursday, share your favorite fair photo!


Friday, April 8 - Wear Red in support of military




Join the Ohio Pork Council and OH-Pigs for their annual Junior Swine Day Event Saturday, April 2, 2022 8am-3pm
