Market Broiler & Market Duck Orders



Again this year, market broilers and market ducks can be ordered through the OSU Extension Office. Birds will be purchased through Meyer Hatchery. The cost of broilers is \$2.25/broiler and ducks are \$7.75/duck. Please note that **EACH EXHIBITOR** must order a minimum of 5 birds. This is a change from previous years. Orders must be placed by July 1st by stopping in our office, 724 S 7th Street, Room 110.

Payment is expected at the time of the order.


- *Picnic tables for the fair
