Coshocton County Livestock Evaluation & Skillathon Sign-Up

You will need to sign up for each species separately (ex. beef feeder and beef breeding you will sign up once, if you have a beef feeder and a market hog you will sign up twice)

Be sure to write down your project evaluation Date and Time! If you have any questions call the OSU Extension Office at 740-622-2265. If a time you signed up for no longer works for you, call the office so we can open that spot up for someone else - do not sign up for multiple times for the same project! If there is no spot available for your selected project call the Extension Office.

The 4-H Food Stand will once again be serving this year at the fair! You can find the food stand in Hunter Arena. Each club takes a turn serving in the food stand during the fair. Proceeds from the food stand go directly to the 4-H Advisory which budgets money each year towards these things: 4-H Camp Scholarships (\$5500), Adult Awards HOF (the plaques in the youth building), Evaluation Days/Skillathon/Banner Club (The food that is provided to all the helpers as well as many awards and fair tickets), Horse Committee (judge for our PAS state fair tryouts), 4-H Promotion (during 4-H Week and more), Shooting Sports, 4-H Camp Ohio, Youth Support (Ohio 4-H Conference and more).
