

Important Changes to Junior Fair Entries

In 2019 junior fair entries will change format. Entries will no longer need to be done as a club but rather as an individual per project. If you prefer completing and submitting them as a club that is still allowable; however, please note we will be charging a late fee of \$5 per class entered past the deadline of August 16th. It takes a lot of time and effort to make all the clubs (4-H and FFA) entries in our office and to prepare the show books. Late entries delay the process and make it difficult for us to get everything ready in time. We are hoping as advisors you can encourage your youth to make their own entries this way.

These new forms will also help tremendously when it comes to penning assignments. They have been revised from forms used in Guernsey County. I have included a sample of the beef entry form so you have an idea of what to expect of each form. We will no longer accept faxed or emailed entries.
