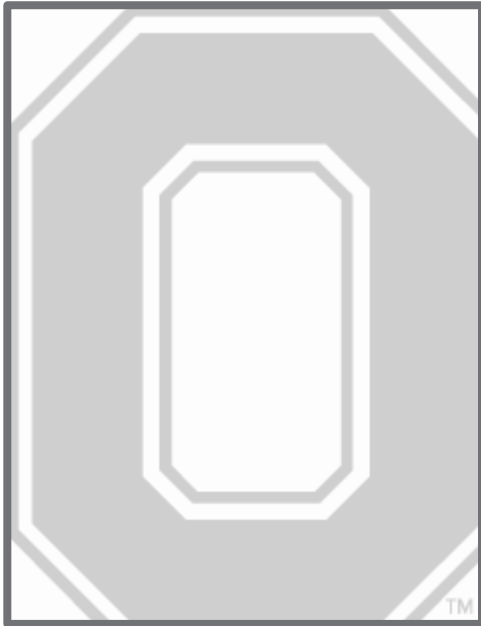
The 2019 4-H theme is:

4-H Advisor Training

Current 4-H volunteers are required to attend an annual training per OSU policy 1.50. This is mandatory and failure to attend will forfeit your volunteer status.

New advisors are also required to complete a new volunteer orientation session. This year it will be combined with the annual mandatory training. You will not be approved as a new advisor unless you attend this session.

Dates for trainings are:

- Tuesday, March 19th, 7:00-9:00 p.m.
- Saturday, April 27th, 9:00-11:00 a.m.
- Thursday, May 23rd, 7:00 -9:00 p.m.

All trainings will be held at the **Coshocton Christian Tabernacle**. Again, every volunteer **MUST** attend one of these trainings. There will be no make-up dates.

***There will be a Cloverbud Advisor Training on April 6th at the Extension Office from 9:00-11:00 a.m. If you attend this training you **DO NOT** have to attend one of the other mandatory advisor trainings. However, if you **CANNOT** attend on April 6th, you will need to attend one of the other three trainings. Call the Extension office to register for the Cloverbud Training.

Camp Counselor Information

Any 4-H member who is 15 years of age or in high school by 1/1/19 may apply to be a 4-H junior camp counselor. Applications can be picked up in the Extension office or can be found on our website at <http://coshocton.osu.edu>

Applications are due by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 8th. No late applications will be accepted.

Individuals who complete the application and fulfill application requirements **MUST** attend the counselor skills test on Monday, March 11, starting at 7:30 p.m. at the Coshocton Christian Tabernacle Church. **Don't be late!**
