### \*\*\*Project Books\*\*\*

You DO NOT need to purchase a new Poultry Project and Record Book Each Year. You are only required to fill out this book your first project year. After your first year you will be able to fill out the Coshocton County Livestock Record papers OR the Poultry Project and Record Book. However, there is no need to fill out both. You may choose which one you complete AFTER your first poultry project year.

## 2019 County Poultry Dates

May 29-June 21 - Market Turkey Hatch Dates.

**June 1, 2019 Poultry Clinic 12:30 p.m. –2:30 Jr. Fair Arena**

**June 21, 2019** Market turkey ownership papers due into the Extension Office

**July 1, 2019** Breeding Poultry must be owned

**July 24, 2019** First date to hatch market ducks

**August 2, 2019** Market duck ownership papers due into the Extension Office

**July 31, 2019** First date to hatch market broilers

**August 9, 2019** Market broiler ownership papers due into the Extension Office

**August 12, 2019 Poultry Evaluations & Skillathon 5:00-9:00 p.m. Grace Church, Coshocton.**

**September 7, 2019** Blood Testing at the fairgrounds 9:00-10:00 pm Any poultry over 16 weeks of age are required to be blood tested unless they can show NPIP (National Poultry Improvement Plan) papers. Ducks and geese do not require blood testing.

**September 26, 2019** 6:00-9:00 pm ALL poultry must be checked for mites/lice and show NPIP or blood testing papers BEFORE unloading!

**September 26, 2019** 6:00-9:00 pm Weigh in for all Market Poultry

**September 26, 2019** Poultry must be in place by 9:00 p.m. Jr. Fair Poultry Barn

**September 27 – October 3, 2019 168th Coshocton County Fair**

**September 28, 2019** Poultry Show 8:00 am start time Jr. Fair Arena

**October 3, 2019** Non-selling poultry projects to be released at 4:00 p.m. Jr. Fair Poultry Barn

**October 3, 2019** Jr. Fair Livestock Auction 5:30 p.m. Hunter Arena with Sale of Champions.

After the sale of champions poultry will sell in order in the Junior Fair Arena.

The Poultry Book OR Livestock Record book **MUST** be completed AND SIGNED by the club Advisor and brought to evaluations **OR YOU CANNOT BE EVALUATED!**

If you wish to compete in the 2019 Poultry Poster contest, please turn them in after you complete your evaluation. (see attached paper on poster contest)

Members wishing to compete for Premiere Poultry Exhibitor will need to complete the Skillathon. Premier Livestock Exhibitors are chosen from a combination of Skillathon, Showmanship and Live Animal Judging. Skillathon scores must be received from participating in each species respective skillathon date; no pre or post evaluations will be accepted. One winner will be announced from each species: horse, dairy, goat, sheep, swine, rabbit, poultry, dog, llama, and small animal. Winners of each species will receive an embroidered director's chair. Winners will be announced at the Showman of Showmen Contest on Wednesday evening of the Coshocton County Fair.

Members will also be asked to recite the 4-H Pledge and the 4-H Motto and general questions about their project.

## Proposed Rule changes for the 2019 Coshocton County Fair



- Change H for broilers: weight between 6-8 pounds
- Blood testing change from 9am-Noon to 9-10am on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of September.
- Class Changes
  1. Split class 2 showmanship into 15 & 16 year olds and 13 & 14 year olds
  2. Add duck pair class – bantam and fancy (the birds shown in this class cannot be shown in any other class except showmanship)
  3. Add peewee showmanship
