## MARKET HOG SHOW - 550

1. All market hog classes can be divided by weight at the discretion of the superintendent. All weight sections are considered an entry in book 550 – Class 1 and Class 2
2. All barrows and gilts must have a measurable ½ inch of body hair, underline included. Ears and tails may be shorter length. Any barrow or gilt may be checked at any time during the exhibition. All hogs in violation will be disqualified and will not sell. Lower placing animals meeting requirements will replace these animals in showing order.
3. An exhibitor may enter two market hogs, one market barrow and one market gilt. Market gilts will be allowed to show in the Junior Fair Market Hog Show, but barrow weight classes will be separate from market gilt weight classes. A Champion and Reserve Champion Market Barrow will be selected and a Champion and Reserve Champion Market Gilt will be selected. These will compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Hog that will sell in the auction. The top 16 carcass hogs will be selected from the top 12 first, second, and third place barrows, and the top 12 first, second, and third place gilts.
4. Market gilt and market barrow class weight ranges will be printed in the Junior Fair Swine Show book.
5. Any market gilt or market barrow exhibitor not wishing to show in the Carcass Show and Champion Drive, must notify the show advisor before the animals enter the ring for Champion Drive. For the Junior Fair Swine Show, the exhibitors not wishing to show in the Champion Drive for market gilt or market barrow must decide and notify a show advisor before these two champion drives of 12 animals begins. Final placings of the top 16 market hogs must go to the carcass show.
6. Junior fair market hog show champion drive – selection of Grand Champion Market Hog, Reserve Grand Champion Market Hog, and 14 additional market hogs for the Carcass Show. After an exhibitor has one animal in the Champion Drive selected for the Carcass Show, then he has the choice to withdraw his second animal in the Champion Drive

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 – Single Barrow

\_\_\_\_\_ 2 – Single Gilt

\_\_\_\_\_ 3 – Exhibitor Home Bred, Born, & Raised Market Hog – exhibitor or exhibitor's immediate family is to own and have the gilt or sow bred that produces the market hog. The exhibitor is not to purchase a bred gilt to produce the market hog for this class (Must also be the exhibitor's Book

550 – Class 1 market barrow entry of Book 550 – Class 2 market gilt entry.

## Book 402 – SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

Exhibitor's age determined by age on January 1 of the current year. Winners of even-numbered age classes move to the next even-numbered age class the following year. Winner of odd-numbered age classes move to the next odd-numbered age class the following year.

\_\_\_\_\_ 12 – Supreme Showmanship. This year's winners of each showmanship class plus previous winners of Senior Showmanship 17 & 18 Division or Supreme winners can only compete in Supreme Showmanship.
