- 1) The club must notify the Extension Office of the location of their window display by March 23rd by calling 740-622-2265.
- 2) The display must be visible even if the business is closed.
- 3) The business must be in Coshocton County.
- 4) The display must contain the following:
  - \*The club name
  - \*OSU Extension contact information
  - \*This year's theme which is "Stay Cool with 4-H"
- 5) The display must be in a window for the entirety of March 26 April 3rd.
- 6) The display must include a notation of "thanks" to the business for allowing the display.
