All proceeds go directly back into our county 4-H program so please stop by Hunter Arena during the fair and support 4-H! **Sign-ups for shifts are first come first serve after banner clubs – this will happen at the next 4-H Advisory meeting on August 24th at 7pm in room 145 of the County Services Building.
