4-H FOOD STAND INFORMATION

The 4-H Food Stand will once again be serving this year at the fair! You can find the food stand in Hunter Arena. Each club takes a turn serving in the food stand during the fair. Proceeds from the food stand go directly to the 4-H Advisory which budgets money each year towards these things: 4-H Camp Scholarships (\$5500), Adult Awards HOF (the plaques in the youth building), Evaluation Days/Skillathon/Banner Club (The food that is provided to all the helpers as well as many awards and fair tickets), Horse Committee (judge for our PAS state fair tryouts), 4-H Promotion (during 4-H Week and more), Shooting Sports, 4-H Camp Ohio, Youth Support (Ohio 4-H Conference and more). All proceeds go directly back into our county 4-H program so please stop by Hunter Arena during the fair and support 4-H! **Sign-ups for shifts are first come first serve after banner clubs – this will happen at the next 4-H Advisory meeting on August 24th at 7pm in room 145 of the County Services Building.
